Biography

NEDIM ĆOSIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Nedim Ćosić was born in 1980, in Tuzla, where he completed his primary education, and then his secondary education at the "Meša Selimović" Grammar School.

In July 2004, he graduated from the Faculty of Law of the University of Sarajevo, and in March 2007 he passed the bar exam at the Ministry of Justice of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

From 2004 to 2006, he did his volunteer practice and his internship at the Municipal Court in Tuzla. After that, from 2006 to 2007, he worked as a Land Records Officer at the Municipal Court in Sarajevo, and later on, in the period from 2007 to 2013, he worked as a Legal Officer at the same Court.

By the Decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina dated 06 March 2013, he was appointed to the position of a Judge at the Municipal Court of Sarajevo, and he took up that office on 1 April 2013. Subsequently, by the Decision of the HJPC of BiH dated 13 April 2023, he was appointed to the position of a Prosecutor at the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina, which office he took up on 8 May 2023.

He has participated in a large number of seminars and professional trainings in the country, in the region, and abroad. He has also been a member of the bodies of several professional judicial associations.

He has published scientific works, and he has been a lecturer and presenter at expert and round table meetings. He has performed the duties of a legal consultant in the country, as well as the duties of an international legal expert abroad.
