Biography

BOŽO MIHAJLOVIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Božo Mihajlović was born in Bosanska Krupa, Bosnia and Herzegovina, in 1957. He graduated from Split University Faculty of Law in 1980.

He began his judicial career as an intern at Livno Municipal Court in 1980 and, after passing the bar exam on 27 October 1982, he was first appointed judge of Livno Municipal Court and then its President (for full two terms) from 1984 to 1992.

In the period from early 1992 to June of the same year he held the position of President of Municipal Court and from that month till October 1997 his career was interrupted because of the war and was unemployed.

From 1997, he worked as a judge of Livno Municipal Court and in November 2001 he was appointed Cantonal Prosecutor in Livno. He is one of the first four prosecutors assigned to the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina in January 2003, and he was appointed Head of Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption in March 2010.

Prosecutor Mihajlović has been working on the most complex organised crime cases within the Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
