

INDICTMENT KT 13/07 AGAINST MIRO MARTIĆ

Sarajevo, 22.05.2007

Pursuant to Article 35 (1) and (2) g) and h), in connection with Article 334 of the Criminal Procedure Code of BiH, an

INDICTMENT

HAS BEEN FILED AGAINST:

MARTIĆ MIRO, nicknamed „Juma“, son of Jerko and mother Kata, nee Pišković, born on 10.10.1973 in Siroki Brijeg, with residence at Posušje, cook by occupation, of Croat nationality, citizen of the Republic of Croatia, without previous convictions

BECAUSE:

On 22 December 2006, around 11:45 p.m., outside of the place designated for the state border crossing, moving along an illegal macadam road leading from Vir-Ričica, municipality of Posušje to the Republic of Croatia, having avoided customs and police control measures, tried to illegally transfer to the Republic of Croatia, on his own car make „Mercedes“, type 124, station wagon, registration plates TS-EW 828, of the German registration zone, the goods of substantial value, or smuggle bigger quantity of cigarettes originating from illegal markets: 2.500 boxes of Walter Wolf 100 S-Gold cigarettes, 3.500 boxes of Ronhill Super Light cigarettes, 7.000 boxes of Ronhill Light cigarettes and 3.500 boxes of Ronhill Blue cigarettes, total of 16.500 boxes of cigarettes make „Ronhill“ and „Walter Wolf“, which contained protective stamps of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Croatia for Ronhill cigarettes, or protective stamps of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia for Walter Wolf cigarettes, at KM 2 retail sale per box, or in total amount of KM 33.000, which action was revealed and prevented by authorized officials of PDGS Gorica,

Therefore, he tried to avoid the custom control measures in order to transfer the goods of substantial value,

by which he committed the criminal offense of smuggling punishable under Article 214 (1) in connection with Article 26 of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
