Biography

VESNA ILIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Vesna Ilić was born in Foča, Bosnia and Herzegovina in 1955. She graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in 1978 and passed the bar exam in 1980.

She did her internship at Sarajevo Basic Court I after which she was an expert associate at the Constitutional Court of the Socialist Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina in Sarajevo.

In the period between 1985 and 2003, she was a Deputy Prosecutor at Sarajevo Basic Prosecutor's Offices I and II, and in the period between 2003 and 2005 she worked as a Cantonal Prosecutor at Sarajevo Cantonal Prosecutor's Office. She was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina on 28 February 2005.

She visited the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY) in The Hague on several occasions. She has been a member of the Association of Prosecutors of Bosnia and Herzegovina since its foundation.
