## ZORICA ĐURĐEVIĆ – PROSECUTOR OF THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Zorica Đurđević was born in Sarajevo on 12 April 1961, where she completed her regular schooling, namely a primary school and 'Treća gimnazija' (Third Classic-Programme Secondary School). She graduated from Sarajevo University Faculty of Law in February 1985 and passed the bar exam in December 1986.

She did her internship at Sarajevo Municipal Court I and in 1987, after passing the bar exam, she was appointed Magistrate at Zenica Misdemeanour Court where she worked until 2 May 1992.

In the period between October 1992 and December 1993, she worked in Istok Municipality – Unit for Property-Legal Affairs, Republic of Serbia. In 1994 she was appointed Magistrate at Istok Municipality Municipal Misdemeanour Court and then, in June 1994, she was appointed judge of the Municipal Court in Istok and held this position until December 1998. In January 1999 she was appointed Deputy District Public Prosecutor for Serb Sarajevo, after which she was appointed a District Prosecutor of the District Prosecutor's Office in East Sarajevo in November 2003, by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

She was appointed Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina by a decision of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council dated 21 December 2012.

She was a member of the Republika Srpska Association of Prosecutors and a member of the Association of Prosecutors of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

During her professional career, she attended many seminars for the purpose of receiving vocational training.
